BPD (2)

1. Chell's, Jimbren Elite Legacy at Ludic. Dk B/W. A youngster full of quality. Square in profile with a lovely reach and arch to his neck with well defined withers which flows nicely into a short strong topline to the croup and perfect tail set. Well up on his toes with good pasterns which gives him an air of nobility. Good angulation. Looking at him front on his legs are straight and of good bone and a nice width and depth of chest. Good spring of rib. Nice skull ratio and good length to muzzle, good stop, kind eye, large nose with evident nostrils, good ear set. Well defined chin, very good mouth with large wide and straight teeth. Its early days yet but if this young lad continues to develop in the way I think he will, I can predict a very bright future for him. Lots of potential. Happy to award him (BBPIS).

2. Huggins, Boxania Rock and Roll Star for Daervlish. Dk B/W. Another very nice puppy presented in beautiful condition. Square and compact. Good angulation and nicely up on his toes. Nice arched neck, defined withers and sloping topline. Viewed from the front presents a nice picture showing strong straight legs, good depth of brisket, nice ear placement, good stop and eye. Evident chin nice lip placement and mouth. Moved well.

BPB (5/2Abs)

1. Parker & Martin, Olleyville Juliette, Dk B/W. Another compact and nicely balanced puppy in good condition with good angulation and well up on her toes. Good length of neck, sloping topline and tail set. Good bone, straight front legs and depth to brisket. The head presents good ear placement and an expressive eye, evident chin, large nose, a square muzzle. Moved really well.

2. Mc Carthy & Gething, Boxania Don't Blame Me at Jeddhi, Mh B/W. Compact and square with good length of neck, sloping topline and nice tail set. Good depth of brisket and straight front legs. Skull has good proportions, has nice ear placement, gentle expressive eye and square muzzle. Moved well.

VD (4/1)

1. Ames, Marbleview Phantom Menace at Thenamy, Mh B/W. Square build, with good angulation and up on his toes. Good condition and muscle tone showing a nice spring of rib. There is plenty of substance about this lad. Fore leg is of good bone and straight with good depth to brisket. Moved out well.

2. Louis, Rameleon Nights In Harlem. B/W. A nice compact boy with good angulation and nicely up on his toes, good depth of brisket and straight strong foreleg, Moved out well.

PD (2)

1. Slaney's, Ellcrys Hephaestus at Slanstorm. B/W, Compact young boy, top end in size for his age. Well up on his toes. Movement restricted as a result of being straight in stifle. Good condition.

2. Law's, Shellark Giant Killing. Mh B/W, Square in outline, nice angulation with level topline, up on toes. Was very unsettled, moved ok.

JD (1)

1. Slaney's, Normybox Monkey Man at Slanstorm. Mh B/W. Very square profile and another tall boy. Level topline and good depth of brisket. Nice bone and straight foreleg. Pleasing head with good mouth. A little erratic on the move. (BPD)

ND (2)

1. Humphries, Lanfrese Cantaro at Chribanna. Dk B/W, Compact boy with good angulation, long neck, well defined withers, strong sloping back and nice tail set. Good chest and depth to brisket. When viewed from the front he has nice straight foreleg of good bone. Skull is of good proportion, good mouth. Good movement.

2. Smith, Slanstorm Supernatural Dean. R/W, Square in profile, good tuck up, would prefer a better turn of stifle nice condition with short dense coat. Good stop but rather heavy with too much padding on muzzle.

PGD (4/2)

1. Van-Beck, Newlaithe Respect. B/W, this boy is starting to mature nicely, square solid with good angulation, lovely forechest, depth to brisket and tuck up. Strong neck, well defined withers with a lovely strong sloping topline and a good tailset. Straight foreleg. Pleasing head of good proportions, would have liked a little more chin to finish it off. Moved out well.
2. Jones, Kevanor In The Summertime. B/W, Square with good angulation, good length of neck with well defined withers and nice tail set, well of for bone and straight foreleg. Skull is of good proportions. I would have preferred a stronger hind action when on the move.

LD (4)

1. Hare's, Jimbren The Irishman (AI) B/W, An elegant upstanding male that carries himself in a noble fashion. This boy has still some maturing to do and should have a bright future ahead of him, very promising. He has a lovely short dense coat and was in top condition. Well of for bone and nice angulation. Every part of him flows nicely from his lovely arched neck down to his tail. Nice forechest and depth of brisket with nice tuck up. His topline has the width and strength to carry his large frame effortlessly around the ring, he was a joy to watch when in full stride. Was delighted to award him (BDIS)
2. Peck & Ames, Winuwuk Line of Duty for Enesha. B/W, Very elegant individual who still needs time to mature and could do with a little more weight to assist. Nice angulation and bone, lovely long arched neck flowing nicely into well defined withers, super topline and tailset. Nice straight foreleg and a lovely clean head with no exaggeration, good ear placement, well defined stop, rise of skull, nice length of muzzle, good mouth. Good mover.

OD (2/1)

1. Mc Donald's, Yeteb Totally Charming. Dk B/W, Stood alone. Square and well of for bone. Good angulation, depth of brisket, nice tuck up. Neck withers and topline are spot on with good width of back. Straight foreleg, nice eye, good mouth. covered the ground with ease. (RBDIS)

VB (4/1)

1. Murfin, Farvalley Instant Love. B/W, Compact 10-year-old, Good angulation, nice bone and front pasterns. Super topline and nice coat. Good head with expressive eye. Moved well. (BVIS)
2. Bole's, Harvlin Rosie May. Plain faced Brindle @ 9 year old that seemed to enjoy her day out. Lovely condition, good angulation, nice bone, and has the most beautiful expression.

MPB (8/3)

1. Van-Beck & Taylor, Crime Squad Newlaithe. Dk B/W, an eye-catching individual nicely put together with good angulation fore and aft. Beautiful length of neck with a flowing arch into well defined withers and a lovely topline and a bang on tail set. She has a lovely expression, a nice eye and nice rise of skull.
2. Murfin & Cobbledick, Farvalley Goody Two Shoes. Dk B/W, Similar type to 1. Good length of neck and level topline. Well up on her toes. Pleasing expression with nice eye and length of muzzle.

PB (2/1)

1. Mc Carthy & Gething, Lorrosa My Heads Been Turned to Jeddhi. B/W, Square in profile, nice rear angulation, good length of neck and well-defined withers flowing into a level topline and good tailset. Nice dept of brisket and tuck up. Well up on toes. The skull is of good proportion finishing with a defined stop, good rise of skull, a nice length of muzzle and neat lip placement.

JB (1)

1. Parker & Martin, Olleyville Odelia. Dk B/W, Eye catching well up on her toes. Lovely condition allover. Spot on rear angulation. Lovely length and arch to neck, well defined withers and nicely sloping topline. Good depth to brisket with gentle tuck up. Good mouth although I would have preferred a longer muzzle. (RBB)

NB (1)

1. Murfin & Cobbledick, Jeddhi Spice It Up at Farvalley. Dk B/W, Compact with good depth to brisket, nice rear angulation, good pasterns and nice feet. Nice head with kind expressive eye.

PGB (9/4)

1. Mullis, Idleforde Crown Jewels. R/W, her body structure reminds me so much of the type you would find on the continent, wiry with muscle under tight skin and a short coat and takes a strong handler to guide her

around the ring. I would advise putting a few more pounds on her as her hyper nature will burn the pounds up very quickly. With that said she has the strength and physical structure to build upon. She has a nice amount of angulation with a lovely length of neck, defined withers and a nice level topline, deep brisket and lovely tuck up. Nice feet and good pasterns. Skull proportions have to be applauded as she has a lovely length of muzzle you don't often see, nice flat cheeks and ear placement, defined stop and gentle rise of skull, large nose and nostrils along with nicely padded muzzle and lip placement. Evident chin and to top it all the most beautiful shaped dark eyes surrounded by a lovely dark mask. Without a doubt the best head of the day.

2. Smith's, Slanstorm Supernatural Sam. Dk B/W, Compact individual and nicely balanced. Good angulation, pasterns and feet. Nice length of neck and sloping topline and tailset. Deep brisket and nice tuck up. Straight foreleg, nice skull all over, but if I was to be a little picky I would like a little longer muzzle. Moved out well.

LB (6/2)

1. Hare's, Jimbren Queen Of Tarts (AI). B/W, What a classy girl she is. From the first moment you put your eyes on her you know you have a special one to put your hands on. Square in profile with a super balance and a lovely combination of elegance and substance. Expertly handled to make her shine for every minute that she was in the ring. The first thing I noticed was the excellent condition she was in, from her lovely short dense coat and the correct amount of covering. Well toned muscles. She has lovely angulation, nice pasterns, good bone, nice turn of stifle, short hock and nice tight feet. Lovely fore chest deep brisket and underline. From her neck through her withers along a nice short topline that has a lovely width to it, finishing with a spot on tail set, plus a nice spring of rib and short loin. She sports a beautiful head piece, with the proportion between the head and muzzle just right, nice ear placement, stop and rise of skull good. A nice pleasing eye that is always alert. Square muzzle with good lip placement and evident chin, good mouth. Strong free striding movement. Delighted to award her (BIS)

2. Harvey & Bole, Harvlin Mystification. B/W, Nice type, with a nice long neck, defined withers, good topline and tailset. Nice tight feet and pasterns, good rear angulation and short hock. Good headpiece with dark expressive eye, square muzzle, good lip placement

OB (3/2)

1. Murfin & Cobbledick, Farvalley Milyon Dolla Baby. R/W, Very elegant with good angles and nice tight feet. Nice short sloping topline and good tailset. Good depth to brisket, short loin. She has a nice eye and ear placement, dark mask.
